



## Toilet Tank Topper

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### Yarn

#### **Bernat Mosaic Yarn - Discontinued.**

Use equivalent weight such as Bernat Super Value or Red Heart Super Saver Ombres.

Fasten off and weave in your ends.

### Hook

- 4.5 mm / G Hook

### Abbreviations

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double Crochet

**Hdc** = Half Double Crochet

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right Side

**Sc** = Single Crochet

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

### Instructions

This tank topper is pretty uniform in size to fit most toilets. I have to admit to you, I'm not a fan of too many fabrics or carpet near a toilet due to the splash zone being a problem for guys. I like my little placemat as it gives the white porcelain a bit of character without having to cover the entire tank up. I love the yarn choice as it does all of the work for colour coordination.

Ch 37.

**Rnd 1:** 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (counts as ch-2 + 1 hdc). 1 hdc in each ch to 2nd last ch. Last ch, (2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc). Continue on the underside of the ch. 1 hdc in each ch to 2nd last ch. (2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc, ch 2). Join with sl st to beg ch-2.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc). 1 hdc in same ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to next ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. 2 hdc) in ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in next sts to next ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. 2 hdc) in ch-2 sp. 1 hdc each st to next ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. 2 hdc) in next ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to last ch-2 sp. (2 hdc, ch 2) in last ch-2 sp. Join with sl st to beg ch 2.

Repeat Step 2, 6 times.
