



Rnd 25-30:	sc around	(20)	□□□□□□
Rnd 31:	(2 sc, dec) x 5	(15)	□
Rnd 32:	(sc, dec) x 5	(10)	□
Rnd 33:	(dec) x 5	(5)	□

Fasten off, leaving a very long tail. With a yarn needle, weave through last rounds stitches using tail and pull gently to close opening. Tie off securely and leave rest of tail for assembly later



Part 6 (make 2 only)

With 4mm(G) hook and approx 16gm of yarn per piece

Rnd 1: Work 8 sc into MR (8) □

Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed

Rnd 2:	(inc) x 8	(16)	□
Rnd 3:	(sc, inc) x 8	(24)	□
Rnd 4:	sc around	(24)	□
Rnd 5:	(2 sc, inc) x 8	(32)	□
Rnd 6-10:	sc around	(32)	□□□□□
Rnd 11:	(2 sc, dec) x 8	(24)	□
Rnd 12:	sc around	(24)	□
Rnd 13:	(sc, dec) x 8	(16)	□
Rnd 14-15:	sc around	(16)	□□
Rnd 16:	(2 sc, dec) x 4	(12)	□
Rnd 17-18:	sc around	(12)	□□
Rnd 19:	(sc, inc) x 6	(18)	□
Rnd 20-23:	sc around	(18)	□□□□

Stuff piece lightly. Continue to stuff piece as you work

Rnd 24: (8 Sc, inc) x 2 (20) □

Part 7 (make 1 only)

With 3.5mm(E) hook and approx 1gm of yarn

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc into MR (5) □

Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed

Rnd 2-8:	sc around	(5)	□□□□□□□
Rnd 9:	2 sc, inc, 2 sc	(6)	□
Rnd 10-12:	sc around	(6)	□□□

*Stuff lightly
Leave a long tail for assembly later.*



Part 8 (make 2)

With 4mm(G) hook and approx 1gm of yarn per piece

ch11

Row 1: dc in 4th ch from hook, 3 hdc, 3 sc
3 sc in last ch. Rotate piece to work
on opposite side of foundation chain.
3 sc, 3 hdc, 2 dc into last ch, turn.

(19) □

Row 2: ch 1, BLO, 9 sc, 3 sc into next,
9 sc (21) □

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With a yarn needle, weave starting tail into work. Leave ending tail for attaching later
