## CLUE #4



### MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast C Mink (10782)

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long. Pair of size U.S. 11 (8 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Cable needle.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**Alt** = Alternate

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**C8B** = Slip next 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold at back of work. K4, then K4 from cable needle.

**C8F** = Slip next 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold at front of work. K4, then K4 from cable needle.

**Cont** = Continue

**K** = Knit

**K2(3)tog** = Knit next 2(3) stitches together

**P** = Purl

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

**RS** = Right side

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

### MEASUREMENTS

Finished blanket approx 46" x 52"  
[117 x 132 cm]

### GAUGE

8 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in  
stocking stitch.

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## INSTRUCTIONS

(See charts on page 9).

### Right side edge

With RS facing, circular needle and C, pick up and knit 102 sts along right side edge, beg at bottom right corner to top right corner. Break yarn.

With pair of double-pointed needles and C, cast on 12 sts.

You will now be working an applied cable border. The last st on the double-pointed needle will be worked with picked-up st(s) on the circular needle on every RS row.

**1st row:** K2. P1. K8. Slip last st on left-hand needle to end of circular needle at bottom right corner. K3tog (slipped st and next 2 sts from circular needle).

**2nd and alt rows:** K1. P8. K3.

**3rd row:** K2. P1. K8. Slip last st on left-hand needle to end of circular. K2tog (slipped st and next st from circular needle).

**5th row:** As 1st row.

**7th row:** K2. P1. C8F. Slip last st on left-hand needle to end of circular needle. K2tog (slipped st and next st from circular needle).

**8th row:** As 2nd row.

These 8 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until all picked-up sts on circular needle have been worked. (WS). Cast off rem 12 sts purlwise.

### Left side edge

With circular needle and C, pick up and knit 102 sts along left side edge, beg at top left corner to bottom left corner. Break yarn.

With pair of double-pointed needles and C, cast on 12 sts.

**1st row:** K2. P1. K8. Slip last st on left-hand needle to end of circular needle. K3tog (slipped st and next 2 picked up sts from circular needle).

**2nd and alt rows:** K1. P8. K3.

**3rd row:** K2. P1. K8. Slip last st on left-hand needle to end of circular. K2tog (slipped st and next st from circular needle).

**5th row:** As 1st row.

**7th row:** K2. P1. C8B. Slip last st on left-hand needle to end of circular needle. K2tog (slipped st and next st from circular needle).

**8th row:** As 2nd row.

These 8 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until all picked-up sts on circular needle have been worked. (WS). Cast off rem 12 sts purl-wise.

**Top edge:** With RS facing, circular needle and C, pick up and knit 106 sts along top edge, beg at top right corner to top left corner.


Break yarn.

Work as given for Right side edge.


**Bottom edge:** With RS facing, circular needle and C, pick up and knit 106 sts along bottom edge, beg at bottom left corner to bottom right corner. Break yarn. Work as given for Left side edge.
