### Hook

5.5 mm / Size I/US 9

### Abbreviations

Beg = Begin  
Ch = Chain  
Dc = Double Crochet  
Rep = Repeat  
RS = Right Side  
Sl St = Slip Stitch  
Sp = Space  
WS = Wrong Side

### The Web

The web uses surface crochet after the square is done. Similar to the Spider Throw by Yarnspirations.



Not only is there surface overlay in the spokes but there is also surface overlay in around the circles between colour changes. The circle is crocheted where each colour has 2 rounds before changing. I will explain the overlay at the end of this pattern. There is also a free tutorial for the Spider Throw already available on our YouTube Channel.

### Instructions

With C Ch 4.

**Round 1:** (RS)11 dc into 4th chain from hook. Join with sl st to top of be chain 3. Fasten off C. - 12 sts

**Round 2:** Fasten on With B, ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 2 dc in each st around. Join with sl st to beg ch. - 24 sts

**Round 3:** Ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next. Repeat \* around. Join with a sl st to beg ch. Fasten off B. - 36 sts

**Round 4:** Fasten on With A ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next 2. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 2. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg ch. - 48 sts

**Round 5:** Ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next 3. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 3. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg ch. Fasten off A. - 60 sts

**Round 6:** Fasten on and With B ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next 4. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 4. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg ch. - 72 sts

**Round 7:** Ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next 5. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 5. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg ch. Fasten off B. - 84 sts

**Round 8:** Fasten on A, with A ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next 6. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 6. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg ch. - 96 sts

**Round 9:** Ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next 7. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 7. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg ch. Fasten off A. - 108 sts

**Round 10:** Fasten on With B ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next 8. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 8. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg ch. - 120 sts

**Round 11:** Ch 3, 1 dc in same st as join. 1 dc in next 9. \*2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 9. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg ch. Fasten off colour B. - 132 sts

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**Round 12:** On RS fasten on colour A to the same stitch as where you fastened off. Join with a sl st. Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as join. 1 sc in next 10. \*2 sc in next stitch, 1 sc in next 10. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg sc. - 144 sts

**Round 13:** Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as join. 1 sc in next 8. \*2 sc in next stitch, 1 sc in next 8. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off and weave in ends. - 160 sts

## Transition to Square

**Round 1:** On RS with MC fasten on with a sl st to any stitch in the circle. Ch 4 (counts as tr), 1 tr in same stitch. The next set of instructions all have 1 crochet stitch in each. Here is the order. \*1 tr in the next 4 stitches, 1 dc in the next 5 stitches, 1 hdc in the next 5 stitches, 1 sc in next 11 stitches, 1 hdc in the next 5 stitches, 1 dc in the 5 stitches, 1 tr in the next 4 stitches, (2 tr, ch 2, 2 tr) in next stitch. Repeat from \* around. Final corner is 2 tr in the same stitch as where you started, ch 2 and then sl st to top of beg ch 4. - 172 sts

**Round 2:** Ch 4, (counts as tr), 1 tr into the previous ch 2 sp. The next set of instructions all have 1 crochet stitch in each. Here is the order. \*1 tr in the next 3 stitches, 1 dc in the next 6 stitches, 1 hdc in the next 6 stitches, 1 sc in next 13 stitches, 1 hdc in the next 6 stitches, 1 dc in the 6 stitches, 1 tr in the next 3 stitches, (2 tr, ch 2, 2 tr) in next ch-2 space. Repeat from \* around. Final corner is 2 tr in the same stitch as where you started, ch 2 and then sl st to top of beg ch 4. - 188 sts

**Round 3:** Ch 3, (counts as dc), 1 dc into the previous ch 2 sp. The next set of instructions all have 1 crochet stitch in each. Here is the order. \*1 dc in the next 7 stitches, 1 hdc in the next 8 stitches, 1 sc in next 17 stitches, 1 hdc in the next 8 stitches, 1 dc in the 7 stitches, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 space. Repeat from \* around. Final corner is 2 dc in the same stitch as where you started, ch 2 and then sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off. - 204 sts

## Final Border

On RS, with A fasten onto ch-2 space with a sl st. ch 3 (counts as dc), 1 dc into same ch-2 space. \*1 dc in each stitch across to next corner. In corners, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc). Repeat \* around. Final corner has 2 dc, ch 2. Sl st to the top of the beg ch 3. Fasten off and weave in ends. - 220 sts

## Surface Overlay

You will need to do 12 spoke surface overlays that go from the center to the last red colour. You will follow the spokes outward using the 1 dc of the group of 2 in each beginning section as your guide. You will single crochet between the spaces. The picture to the immediate right is the back of the square itself.

You will fasten onto the middle one post of Round 1. Ch 1, sc in the same post. Ch 1, single crochet around the next 1 dc

post in the group of 2 in the next round. Ch 1, 1 sc in next post in the next round outward. Continue in same manner extending to the final red round. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Do each spoke in the same fashion.

There are 3 rounds of white surface overlay that circle around. Notice the picture on where it appears. I felt it was too much to surface crochet around each colour band. So I went every other one.

Fasten onto any st in the colour you want to circle. Ch 1, 1 sc in same. Place 1 sc in each stitch around, with exception to passing over the middle spokes. To pass over the spokes, ch 1 and skip it and sc into the next stitch on the other side. Fasten off when all the way around and do two more surface overlay rounds to finish the look.




# Action Packed Main Circle

This diagram is used in the following Action Packed Squares, they include Diamond Square, Belt Square, Hammer Square, Web Square, Circle of Stars Square, Spotlight Square, Star Circle, Lightning Square and POW Square.

STITCH KEY

○	= chain (ch)
•	= slip st (sl st)
+	= single crochet (sc)
⌋	= double crochet (dc)



The POW Square uses Tapestry Crochet Techniques of carrying the yarn under the stitches. The same stitches and counts are used, but drop and pick up yarn as required for tapestry techniques.
