Crochet Nightberry Shawl Pattern

I love a simple shawl to just take the chill off my shoulders. This design was created using just one [Caron Big Cake](#) to make great use of the fabulous self-stripping effect. There is no attached collar. The look is created simply by folding down the top few rows of the shawl when draping it over your shoulders.

Nightberry Shawl

- Caron Big Cake – 1 ball
- Crochet Hook 6.00mm Size J

Special Stitch – V-st = dc, ch 2, dc

Row 1 – Ch 17, in 4th ch from hook 3 dc, dc in each ch, 4 dc in last ch.

Turn. – 20 dc

Row 2 – Ch 3 (counts as dc now and throughout), 3 dc in same st; dc in each st across, 4 dc in last st. Turn. – 26 dc

Row 3 – Ch 3, 3 dc in same st, sk next dc, V-st in next, *sk 2, V-st in next; rep * until 2 st rem, sk next st, 4 dc in last st. Turn. – 8 dc, 8 V-st

Row 4 – Ch 3, 3 dc in same st, dc in next 3 st, sk next st, 3 dc in ch-2 sp of V-st, *sk 2 dc, 3 dc in ch-2 sp; rep * in all ch-2 sps, sk next st, dc in next 3 st, 4 dc in last st. Turn. – 38 dc

Row 5 – Rep row 2. Turn. – 44 dc

Row 6 – Rep row 3. Turn. – 8 dc, 14 V-st

Row 7 thru 27 – Rep row 4, 5 and 6.

Row 28 – Rep row 4.

Stop Increasing

Row 29 – Ch 3, dc in each st across. Turn.

Row 30 – Ch 3, sk st, V-st in next st, *sk 2 dc, V-st; rep * to last 2 st, sk st, dc in last st. Turn.

Row 31 – Ch 3, 3 dc in each ch-2 sp across, dc in last st. Turn.

Row 32 thru 34 – Rep rows 29, 30, and 31.

Row 35 – Rep row 29.



Row 36 – Rep row 30.

Edging – Row 37 – Ch 1, sc in first st, (sc, ch 1, sc, ch 1, sc) in each ch-2 sp across, sc in last st. Finish off.
