Hook

8 mm / L Hook

Abbreviations

Beg = Begin
Ch = Chain
Rep = Repeat
Sl St = Slip Stitch
Sp = Space
Dc3tog = Double Crochet 3 together.

Easy to Crochet

Use 2 strands of regular 4 ply worsted yarn. Use your those pesky scrap yarn balls that may be lying around.

Putting two strands together can provide unique coloring and really a homemade look and feel to your finished afghans.



Instructions

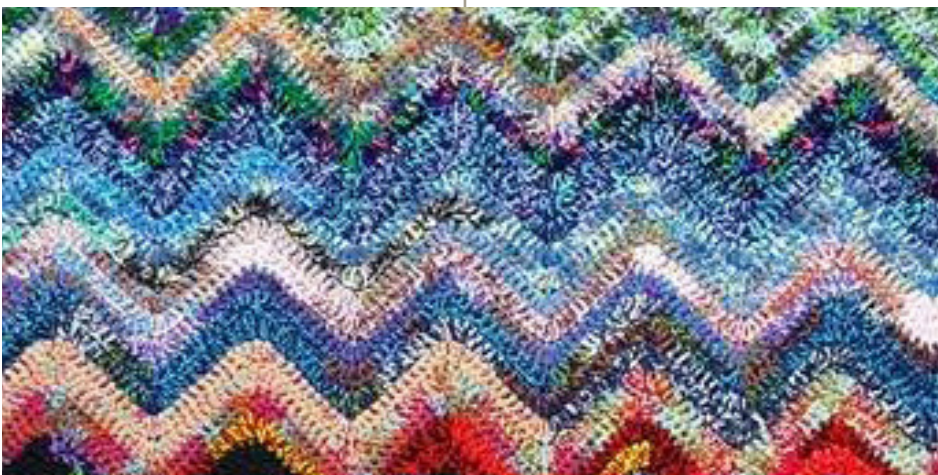
Using 2 strands together.

With 2 strands Color A held together, **ch 123**.

Row 1 – 2 dc in 4th chain from hook, *dc in next 8 chains, [dc3tog in next 3 chains] twice, dc in next 8 chains, [3 dc in next chain] twice. Repeat * to end, 3 dc into last chain. Turn.

Row 2 – Ch 3, 2 dc into same stitch. *dc into next 8 stitches, [dc3tog] twice, dc into next 8 stitches, [3 dc into next stitch] twice. Repeat * to end, 3 dc into last stitch. Turn.

Continue Row 2 until desired length.
