BRIGHT ZIG-ZAG STRIPES CROCHET BLANKET | CROCHET



MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Contrast A White (39701)

Contrast B Neon Orange (39774)

Contrast C Neon Yellow (39773)

Contrast D Neon Pink (39775)

2 balls

2 balls

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.

ABBREVIATIONS: www.yarnspirations.com/abbreviations

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue

Dc = Double crochet

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next st at back of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh, draw through 2 loops on hook) twice - dcbp made.

Hdc = Half double crochet

HdcCL = Yoh and draw up a loop in next st. Skip next st. Yoh and draw up a loop in next st. Yoh and draw through all 5 loops on hook – HdcCL made.

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

SI st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tr = Treble crochet

TrCL = Keeping last loop of each tr on hook, 1 tr in next st, skip next st, 1 tr in next st, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

TrCL made.WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook



MEASUREMENTS

Approx 40" [101.5 cm] wide x 48" [122 cm] long.

GAUGE

13 dc and 6 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes

- Foundation ch: multiple of 19 + 3.
- To join new color, work to last 2 loops on hook. Draw new color

through last 2 loops then proceed in new color.

• Ch 2 counts as hdc.

Stripe Pat

Work 2 rows of each color in the following sequence: (A, C, A, B) twice (16 rows), (A, D) twice (8 rows), (A, B, A, C) twice (16 rows), (A, D) twice (8 rows), (A, C, A, B) twice (16 rows), (A, D) twice (8 rows), (A, B, A, C) twice (16 rows), A (2 rows) – these 90 rows form Stripe Pat.



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Blanket

With A, ch 136.

1st row: (WS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 7 ch. HdcCL. *1 hdc in each of next 7 ch. 2 hdc in each of next 2 ch. 1 hdc in each of next 7 ch. HdcCL. Rep from * to last 9 ch. 1 hdc in each of last 9 ch. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 2. Skip first st. Dcbp in each st to end of row. Join B. Turn.

3rd row: With B, ch 5. In first st work (1 tr. Ch 1) twice. (Skip next st. 1 tr in next hdc) 3 times. Skip next hdc. TrCL. (Skip next st. 1 tr in next st) 3 times. *Ch 1. Skip next st. In next st work [(1 tr. Ch 1) twice. 1 tr]. In next st work (1 tr. Ch 1) 3 times. (Skip next st. 1 tr in next st) 3 times. Skip next st. TrCL. (Skip next st. Tr in next st) 3 times. Rep from * to last 2 sts. Ch 1. Skip next st. In top of turning ch work [(1 tr. Ch 1) twice. 1 tr]. Turn.

4th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first tr. 1 dc in each st and ch-1 sp to end of row, ending with 1 dc in 5th ch and 2 dc in 4th ch of ch 5. Join A. Turn.

5th row: With A, ch 2. Skip first dc. 1 hdc in each of next 8 dc. HdcCL. *1 hdc in each of next 7 dc. 2 hdc in each of next 2 dc. 1 hdc in each of next 7 dc. HdcCL. Rep from * to last 9 dc. 1 hdc in each of last 9 dc. Join C. Turn. First 5 rows of Stripe Pat are

Cont in pat, keeping cont of Stripe Pat, until all 90 rows of Stripe Pat will be complete. **Do not** fasten off. **Do not** turn.

complete. Rows 2 to 5 form Pat.

Left side edges: 1st row: (RS). With A, ch 2. Work 162 hdc evenly down left side edge of Blanket to bottom corner. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Fasten off.

With RS facing, join A with sl st to bottom right corner. Work as given for left side.

Pompom: (make 15). Wind A around 3 fingers 80 times. Tie tightly in the middle and leave a long end for attaching to Blanket. Cut loops at both ends and trim to form pompom.

Attach 1 pompom to each point across both edges of Blanket.
