### Special Stitch


**Bean Stitch** - Insert hook in next st, YO and pull up a loop (2 loops on hook), YO in same stitch and pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), YO in same stitch once more and pull up a loop (6 loops on hook), YO and pull through all 6 loops on hook, ch 1 to complete stitch.

### Introduction

Introducing the bean stitch. This is an old stitch that provides texture on both sides of the project. A great way to play with colour and self striping yarns.

Generally speaking, we find it easier than the puff stitch. It's easy to remember and do without much thought. It creates the stitch to lean over creating an interlocking stitch design.

It reminds us of a woven basket when completed.

### Instructions

Chain any even number for an odd number of sc.

#### Ch 20

**Row 1:** Sc 2nd chain from hook. Sc in each st across. Turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*sk next st, bean st in next st; rep from \* until 2 sts left, sk next st, sc in last st. Turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, bean st in ch-1 sp of each bean st across, sc in last sc. Turn.

**Row 4 - 7:** Rep row 3.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, sc in first st, 2 sc in ch-1 sp of each bean st across, 2 sc in last sc. Turn.
