3 Balls - Caron Cotton Cakes, Bushing Melon

Hook

4 mm / G Hook

Abbreviations

- Beg = Beginning
- Ch = Chain
- Fpdc = Front Post Double Crochet
- Rep = Repeat
- RS = Right Side
- Sc = Single Crochet
- Sl st = Slip Stitch
- sctog = Single Crochet Together
- Rnd: Round

Introduction

Introducing the Waffle Stitch Bag. It's comprised of strategically placing front post double crochets. To keep the balance and the true waffle appearance, you are required to **change directions** at the end of each round. I demonstrate that in a tutorial. If you don't turn around, you will end up with a waffle that has a lean to it. It's easy to complete and you will have a bag in no time. For your convenience, Daniel has made a diagram for me to further illustrate how this is done.



Project Size

11.5" wide x 13" tall. Excluding handles.

Instructions

Multiples are in sets of 3 if you would like to change the size.

Body of Bag

Ch 99, sl st to first ch to form ring. Do not twist chain.

Rnd 1: WS - Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in each chain around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. **Turn.** - 99 sts.

Rnd 2: RS - Ch 3, dc in next st. fpdc in next. *Dc in next 2 sts, fpdc in next. Repeat * around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. **Turn.** - 99 sts

Rnd 3: WS - Ch 2 (does not count as st here and throughout), fpdc around same ch-3 post in rnd below. Dc in next. *Fpdc in next 2 sts, dc in next. Repeat * around. Fpdc in last st. Join with sl st to beg fpdc. **Turn.** - 99 sts

Rnds 4: RS - Ch 3, dc in next st. fpdc in next. *Dc in next 2 sts, fpdc in next. Repeat * around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. **Turn.** - 99 sts

Repeat Rnds 3 - 4: Until approximately 11" ending on rnd 4.

Top Band

Rnd 1: Fasten on, ch 1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to beg sc.

Rnd 2 - 4: Ch 1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Base of Bag

Turn upside down and attach to the bottom of the bag.

Rnd 1: Join with sl st. Ch 1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to beg sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog. Repeat * around. Join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off, leaving 30" tail.

Fold bag in half and lay flat. Whip stitch with remaining tail across the base of the bag to seal bottom shut. Secure loose ends.

Straps - Make 2

Ch 100.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn.

2nd to 5th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

Fold Strap in half lengthwise and working through both thicknesses to join 5th row to foundation row, work 1 sc in each st to end of row.

Sew straps to bag approximately 3.5" from the edges.
