



# Felted iPad Case for Original Size 9.5" x 7.5"

## Skill Level

- Easy

## Designer

- Michael Sellick - Mikey

## Yarn

- Patons Classic Wool. Assorted colours. Must use 100% wool for felting.

## Hook

- 6 mm / J Hook

## Sizing

- 8" wide x 9.5" tall

## Abbreviations

Appox = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain

Rep = Repeat

Sl St = Slip Stitch

Sc = Single Crochet

RS = Right Side

## Introduction

Protect your iPad or Tablets when storing or traveling. Felting the 100% wool will create a thick bag.

## Instructions

### Ch 48

**Round 1: (RS)** Sc 2nd chain from hook, sc in each across. Final stitch, 3 sc. Working on the backside of chain, sc in each ch. Last ch, 2 sc. Join with sl st beg sc.

**Rounds 2 - 56:** Ch 1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to beg sc.



## Colours shown in sample are as follows in rounds.

Beg Ch and first 2 rounds using Orange

- 5 Jade Heather
- 2 Yellow
- 2 Red
- 5 Leaf Green
- 2 Jade Heather
- 1 Yellow
- 4 Burgandy
- 3 Orange
- 1 Jade Heather
- 5 Red
- 2 Leaf Green
- 5 Yellow
- 3 Burgandy
- 1 Orange
- 4 Jade Heather
- 1 Yellow
- 8 Red
- 1 Leaf Green

## Handles - Make 2

**Prepare:** Lay bag down flat. Measure 2" from the edge. This is your starting stitch.

**Row 1:** Attach to starting location. Ch 1, sc in same st as join. Sc in next 4 sts. Turn.

**Row 2 - 36:** Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn. Fasten off on last row and leave long enough tail to sew to the edge.

Measure 2" in from the opposite side,

sew last row edge to top of the bag.

Turn back over, repeat for other handle.

## Felting

Before felting, ensure all loose ends are taken care of and woven in.

1. Load bag into washing machine with a pair of old jeans. Jeans provides agitation to felt up this bag.
2. Add 2 table spoons of baking soda.
3. Water must be as hot as possible.
4. Wash on regular cycle.
5. Take out of washer, shape the bag and lie it flat on a heating register in your house or a place where it can dry. Will take about 24 hours to dry.
