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### Yarn

Bernat Mosaic - 17 Balls. Into the Woods. Yarn line is discontinued.

### Hook

- 5.5 mm / I Hook

### Abbreviations

Beg = Begin(ning)  
Ch(s) = Chain(s)  
Dc = Double Crochet  
Rep = Repeat  
Sk = Skip  
Sl St = Slip Stitch  
Sp = Space

**Size:** 65" x 65"

### Tip

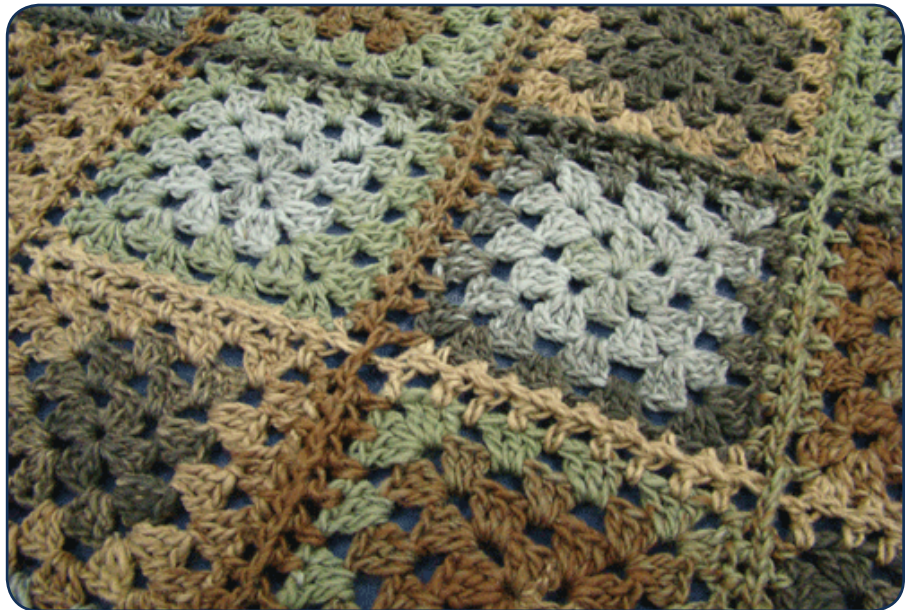
When using transitioning yarn, you can get twice amount of options for colouring out of the balls of yarn. If you crochet half of the squares using the ball pulling from the centre and then do the other half of the squares pulling yarn from the outside of the ball. This will change the order of the colour sequence. The squares are small, so you can have a significant variety of colours of squares.

### Make 143 Squares

Ch 6; sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, ch 2, [3 dc in ring, ch 2] 3 times; join with sl st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp (corner made), ch 1, \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made), ch 1; repeat from \* around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch—24 dc, 4 ch-2 sps, and 4 ch-1 sps



**Rnd 3:** Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; repeat from \* around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch—36 dc, 4 ch-2 sps, and 8 ch-1 sps (4 corners with 3-dc on each side).

**Rnd 4:** Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same corner ch-2 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] twice, ch 1, \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] twice, ch 1; repeat from \* around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch—48 dc, 4 ch-2 sps, and 12 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

### Attaching Squares - Zig Zag Concept

Lay out your squares to ensure it looks balanced. Ensure to double check to ensure the squares are facing correct way. Please note that sts referenced also include ch-1 sps.

Join yarn to first ch-2 sp of first Motif. With WS tog, ch 1. 1 sc in corner ch-2 sp of second Motif. \*Ch 1. Skip next st of first Motif. 1 sc in next st of first Motif. Ch 1. Skip next st of second Motif. 1 sc in next st of second Motif. Rep from \* to end of row, always working into corner ch 2 sps.

Do not fasten off after attaching 2 squares together. Continue to join the next 2 across and continue across afghan.

Once all joins are made in one direction, turn afghan and do same procedure for the remaining open joins to finish off the afghan.
