

Crocodile Stitch Rio Scarf

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Yarn

Bernat Mosaic - 4 Balls. Vivid. Yarn line is discontinued.

Hook

6 mm / J Hook

Abbreviations

Beg = Begin(ning) Ch(s) = Chain(s)

Dc = Double Crochet

Rep = Repeat

Sc = Single Crochet

Sk = Skip

SI St = Slip Stitch

Rev: 1

Scarf Measurements: 80" long x 7.5" wide

Make 2 Panels

Ch 21.

Row 1: 1 dc 3rd ch from the hook. *Ch 2 and sk 2 chs on the chain. 2 dc in next st. Rep * across. Turn. - Foundation mesh created.

Row 2: Ch 3, counts as dc there and throughout. 4 dc down post below. Ch 1. 5 dc up next post. *Ch 1, sk next 2 dc posts, 5 dc down next dc post, ch 1, 5 dc up next dc post. Repeat * across. Turn. - 4 scales across

Row 3: Ch 1, sl st into next gap space between pair of dc sts. Ch 3, 1 dc in same gap sp. *Ch 2, 2 dc in next sp between next pair of 2 dc sts. Repeat * across. Turn. - Foundation mesh created

The next layer of scales will appear to rest between the 4 that are already present created 2 rows before.

Row 4: Ch 1. Sk first 2 dc posts. 5 dc down next dc post, ch 1. 5 dc up next dc post. *Ch 1, sk next 2 dc posts, 5



dc down next dc post, ch 1, 5 dc up next dc post. Repeat * across. Ch 1. 1 sc in gap space between last pair of dc posts. - 4 scales across

Row 5: Ch 3, 1 dc in same gap sp. *Ch 2, 2 dc in next sp between next pair of 2 dc sts. Repeat * across. Turn. - Foundation mesh created

Repeat: 2 - 5: Repeat using up 2 balls of Bernat Mosaic. Ending on row 2. Fasten off.

Make the second panel. Sew them together so the scales face out from the seams. This allows the crocodile stitching to be in the down motion on both sides of your neck when wearing.
