



BERNAT® SIMPLE BABY BLANKET | CROCHET



1  BEGINNER

MEASUREMENT

Approx 34" [86.5 cm] wide x 36" [91.5 cm] long.

GAUGE

5 sc and 6 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Chain (ch) 50.

1st row: 1 single crochet (sc) in 2nd ch from hook. *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Repeat (rep) from * to end of chain. Turn. 49 stitches (sts).

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 space (sp). *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. Rep 2nd and 3rd rows for pattern (pat) until work from beginning (beg) measures 35" [89 cm]. **Do not** fasten off.

Edging: 1st round (rnd): Ch 1. Work 1 rnd of sc evenly around outer edge of Blanket, working 3 sc in each corner. Join with slip stitch (sl st) to first sc. Fasten off.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Peachy (04510)

2 balls

Size U.S. N/15 (10 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
