



## Brick Block Granny Border

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### Yarn

- Bernat Super Value Yarn

### Hook

• 5.5 mm / I Hook or Size that Matches Your Yarn

### Abbreviations

Beg = Begin(ning)  
Ch(s) = Chain(s)  
Dc = Double Crochet  
Rep = Repeat  
Sc = Single Crochet  
Sk = Skip  
Sl St = Slip Stitch

Sp = Space  
Tr = Trebles

### Pattern for Just the Regular Granny Square

Note: Ch 6 at beg of rnd counts as dc and ch 3.

**Rnd 1:** With A, ch 5. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring. 1st rnd: Ch 6. (3 dc. Ch 3) 3 times in ring. 2 dc in ring. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. (Four groups of 3 dc, four ch-3 sps forming corners).

**Rnd 2:** Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. \*Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. Fasten off.

**Rnd 3:** Join B with sl st in any ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. \*Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. 3 dc in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. \*Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. Rep from \*twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. Fasten off.



Rep last rnd, working 2 rnds each of A, B, C, D and E, until square measures approx 36" [91.5 cm], ending with 2 rnds of any color. Fasten off.

### Border Instructions

This border gives the illusion of bricks and Diva Dan and I couldn't decide if it should be called bricks or block, thus we called it Brick Block. Round 3 has overlays of trebles extending and wrapping around the posts in round 1. It hides a partial of round two giving the illusion of the round two appearing to be blocked.



**Rnd 1:** Fasten on to any ch-3 space. Ch 3, 4 dc into the same space. \*Dc into each stitch and ch-1 space to the next corner. In corners, place 5 dc into the ch-3 space. Repeat \* around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Fasten onto the middle dc in the group of 5 in a corner, ch 3, 4 dc into the same stitch. \*1 dc into each stitch to the next corner. Corners are the middle dc of the 5 in a corner, place 5 dc into that stitch. Repeat \* around. Join with a slip stitch to top of beginning ch-3.

**Rnd 3:** Fasten onto middle of the 5 dc in a corner. Ch 1, 3 sc into the same stitch. \*Sc into the next 3 stitches, front post treble crochet (FPTR) to matching post straight down in round 1. Sc into the next 3, FPTR into the next. Repeat \* until next corner ending with 3 sc and then place 3 sc into the middle of the 5 dc. Start \* again and go around in same fashion. Look at the picture believe and compare where the FPTR. The corners stay free of this stitch. Join with a slip stitch to beginning sc.

**Rnd 4:** Fasten onto the middle sc of the group of 3 in a corner. Ch 1, 3 sc into same space. \*1 sc into each stitch to next corner. 3 sc into the middle 3-sc in a corner. Repeat \* around. Join with a slip stitch to the beginning sc. Finish.
