



Double Crochet Granny Border

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Yarn

- Bernat Super Value Yarn

Hook

• 5.5 mm / I Hook or Size that Matches Your Yarn

Abbreviations

Beg = Begin(ning)
Ch(s) = Chain(s)
Hdc = Half Double Crochet
Dc = Double Crochet
Rep = Repeat
Sc = Single Crochet
Sk = Skip

Sl St = Slip Stitch
Sp = Space

Pattern for Just the Regular Granny Square

Note: Ch 6 at beg of rnd counts as dc and ch 3.

Rnd 1: With A, ch 5. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring. 1st rnd: Ch 6. (3 dc. Ch 3) 3 times in ring. 2 dc in ring. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. (Four groups of 3 dc, four ch-3 sps forming corners).

Rnd 2: Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join B with sl st in any ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6.

Rnd 4: Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. 3 dc in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. Rep from *twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. Fasten off.



Rep last rnd, working 2 rnds each of A, B, C, D and E, until square measures approx 36" [91.5 cm], ending with 2 rnds of any color. Fasten off.

Border Instructions

This border has 3 rounds but isn't limited to 3 rounds. Once you get the first round done, you can go around as many times as you need to make the border as thick as you need it to. It's pretty easy.



Rnd 1: Fasten onto any ch-3 space. Ch 3, 4 dc into the same space. *1 dc into each stitch across and ch-1 spaces to the next corner. Next corner, 5 dc into the ch-3 space. Repeat * around. Slip stitch to the top of the beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Fasten onto the middle stitch 5-dc stitch, Ch 3, 4 dc into the stitch. *1 dc into each stitch across and ch-1 spaces to the next corner. Next corner, 5 dc into the middle dc of the group of 5. Repeat * around. Slip stitch to the top of the beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Repeat Step 2 as many times you need. In the picture below, there are only 3 rounds.

If you prefer not to change colour, when you get back around, slip stitch to the top of beginning ch-3. To start the next round, slip stitch to the middle 5-dc and begin the next round by using the instructions above.
