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Yarn

- Bernat Super Value Yarn

Hook

• 5.5 mm / I Hook or Size that Matches Your Yarn

Abbreviations

Sp = Space

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch(s) = Chain(s)

Dc = Double Crochet

Rep = Repeat

Sc = Single Crochet

Sk = Skip

Sl St = Slip Stitch

Pattern for Just the Regular Granny Square

Note: Ch 6 at beg of rnd counts as dc and ch 3.

Rnd 1: With A, ch 5. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring. 1st rnd: Ch 6. (3 dc. Ch 3) 3 times in ring. 2 dc in ring. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. (Four groups of 3 dc, four ch-3 sps forming corners).

Rnd 2: Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join B with sl st in any ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6.

Rnd 4: Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. 3 dc in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. Rep from *twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. Fasten off.



Rep last rnd, working 2 rnds each of A, B, C, D and E, until square measures approx 36" [91.5 cm], ending with 2 rnds of any color. Fasten off.

Border Instructions

This playful border edge reminds us of petals of a flower. You can have a lot of fun with the colour combinations to make your afghan have a neat finished look. The border is about 2" thick and consists of 4 rounds. The first round only concentrates in the ch-1 spaces around a typical granny. This will make the border go quick for completion.



Rnd 1: Fasten onto any ch-3 space, ch 1, 1 sc, ch 1, sc into the same space. *Ch 4, 1 sc into the next ch-1 space. Repeat * to next corner. In corners sc, ch 1, sc into the ch-3 space. Repeat * again. Continue in same manner around. Join with a with a slip stitch to the first sc.

Rnd 2: Slip stitch into the next ch-1 space. Sc, ch 1, sc into the same space. Place 7 sc into each ch-4 space around. In corners, sc, ch 1, sc. Repeat in same manner around. Join with a slip stitch to beginning sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Fasten onto ch-1 space in a corner. Ch 1, sc, ch 1, sc into same space. *Ch 5, sc into space between groups of 7 sc all the way around. In corners, place ch 1, sc, ch1 in ch-1 spaces. Repeat in same manner around. Join with a slip stitch to beginning sc.

Rnd 4: Slip stitch to next ch-1 space. Ch 1, sc, ch 1, sc into same space. each one of the final petal rounds have 8 stitches in the ch-5 spaces. Each ch-5 will have as follows, sc, hdc, dc, tr, tr, dc, hdc, sc. You will skip over the sc's and do each ch-5 space the same. In corners, sc, ch 1, sc. Repeat in same manner all the way around. Join with a slip stitch to first sc. Fasten off.

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
