MC - Gold, 1 Ball  
A - Black, 1 Ball

### Hook

5.5 mm / Size I/US 9

### Abbreviations

Beg = Begin  
Ch = Chain  
Dc = Double Crochet  
Hdc = Half Double Crochet  
Rep = Repeat  
RS = Right Side  
Sl St = Slip Stitch  
Sp = Space

### The Belt & Buckle

This motif is made up of 2 sections. One long strip that is bent in the middle to follow the seam line. If you are not having a seam line in your circle,



the bend isn't too extreme so it lays flat.

There is a granny square that is uniquely shaped that sits over the middle section of the belt.

Both the belt and buckle are sewn directly to the project.

### Instructions

Start with a belt strip.

With MC Ch 44.

**Row 1:** Sc 2nd chain from hook in sc in next 20 stitches. 3 sc in next stitch, 1 sc in final 21 stitches. Turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 1 sc in each st across. Fasten off MC. Turn.

**Row 3:** Fasten on A. Ch 1, 1 sc in each st across. Fasten off A, Turn.

**Row 4:** Fasten on MC. Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch across. Turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in each stitch across. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

### Granny Belt Buckle

**Round 1:** Ch 3, 11 dc in 3rd chain from hook. Sl st to top of begin ch-3 to form circle.

**Round 2:** Ch 3 (counts as double crochet here and throughout), 1 dc in same stitch. 2 dc in each st around.

**Round 3:** Ch 3, 1 tr, 1 dc in same stitch. Sc in next 2 stitches, \* (dc, tr, dc) in next stitch. sc in next 2 stitches. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to top

of beg ch-3.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, (sc, hdc, dc, picot, dc, hdc, sc) in same stitch. 1 sc in next 4 stitches. 3 sc in next stitch. 1 sc in next 4. \* (sc, hdc, dc, picot, dc, hdc, sc) in same stitch. 1 sc in next 4 stitches. 3 sc in next stitch. 1 sc in next 4. Repeat \* around. Join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Sew the motifs into position to form the look of a belt.
