

## Caron Cupcakes Knitted Hat

SIZES: To fit child sizes **2 (4-6-8-10)**.

MATERIALS: Caron Cupcakes™ (3 oz/85 g; 244 yds/vgs/223 m)

Size U.S. 6 (4 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain.

### GAUGE/TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.



### INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ).

Cast on 90 (94-98-98-102) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

**2nd row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P2. Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 1" [2.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row and dec 1 (3-1-1-1) st(s) evenly across last row. 89 (91-97-97-101) sts. Proceed in stocking st until Hat from beg measures 5. (6-6.-7-7.)" [14 (15-16.5-18-18.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

**Shape crown: 1st row:** \*K9 (7-10-10-23). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 81 (81-89-89-97) sts.

**2nd and following WS rows:** Purl.

**3rd row:** \*K8 (8-9-9-10). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 73 (73-81-81-89) sts.

**5th row:** \*K7 (7-8-8-9). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 65 (65-73-73-81) sts.

**7th row:** \*K6 (6-7-7-8). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 57 (57-65-65-73) sts.

**9th row:** \*K5 (5-6-6-7). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 49 (49-57-57-65) sts.

**11th row:** \*K4 (4-5-5-6). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 41 (41-49-49-57) sts.

**13th row:** \*K3 (3-4-4-5). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 33 (33-41-41-49) sts.

**15th row:** \*K2 (2-3-3-4). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 25 (25-33-33-41) sts.

**17th row:** \*K1 (1-2-2-3). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 17 (17-25-25-33) sts. Sizes 6, 8 and 10 only: 18th row: Purl.

**19th row:** \*K(1-1-2). K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. (17-17-25) sts.

**Size 10 only: 20th row:** Purl. 21st row: \*K1. K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 17 sts.

All sizes: Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts and draw up tightly. Sew center back seam. Sew pompom to top of Hat.
