MEASUREMENTS

Approx 39" x 36" [99 x 90.5 cm].

MATERIALS

Sheep(ish)[™] by Vickie Howell (85 g/3 oz, 153 m/167 yds)

	Contrast A Magenta(ish) (00006)	1 ball
	Contrast B Chartreuse(ish) (00020)	1 ball
	Contrast C Pumpkin(ish) (00013)	1 ball
	Contrast D Robins Egg(ish) (00018)	1 ball

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = Chain

Dc = Double crochet

3dctog = Decrease 3 stitches in to one by double-crocheting them together

Sp = Space

	Contrast E Black(ish) (00001)	1 ball
	Contrast F Taupe(ish) (00011)	1 ball
	Contrast G Red(ish) (00015)	1 ball
	Contrast H Turquoise(ish) (00017)	1 ball

Size 6 mm (U.S. J-10) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Tapestry needle.

GAUGE

13 sts x 6 rows= 4" [10 cm] in pat st.

INSTRUCTIONS


Note: To make a larger version, increase stitches by multiples of 14 sts + 1. Don't forget to add an additional 3 for your foundation chain!

With A, ch 130.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook, *dc in each of 5 ch, 3dctog over next 3 ch, dc in each of 5 ch, [dc, ch, dc] in next ch, repeat from *, ending with 2 dc in last ch. Turn.

Row 2: 3 ch, dc in front loop of first dc, * dc in front loop of each of 5 dc, 3dctog, over front loops of next 3 dc, dc in front loop of each of 5 dc, [dc, ch, dc] in ch sp, repeat from *, ending with 2 dc in 3rd of 3 ch. Turn.

Row 3: As for Row 2, but working in the BACK loops of stitches. Repeat Rows 2 & 3 until blanket measures 36" [90 cm] and switching to B, C, D, E, F, G & H every 4 rows for the first half of blanket, and every 2 rows for the 2nd half, ending with 4 rows of A. Use Color Stripe Chart as a guide. Fasten off.



FINISHING

Weave in ends.
