

Texture Scarf

Intermediate

- 2 Balls - Caron Sprinkle Cakes.

Hook

8 mm / L Hook

Abbreviations

Beg = Begin

Ch = Chain

Rep = Repeat

Sl St = Slip Stitch

Sp = Space

Dcfn = Double Croche Front Post

Dcbp = Double Crochet Back Post

Easy to Crochet

A thick ribbed stitch scarf. Using the new Caron Chunky Cakes for a quicker to make scarf. Chunky is in style.

Scarf is 60" long x 6" wide. Fringe not included. Yarn suggested has enough yarn to do the fringe.



Instructions

Ch 23.

1st row: Sc 2nd chain from hook. Sc across chain. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3, dc in each st across. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1, sc in each across. Turn.

4th row: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1 here and throughout), skip first sc. *work **dcfn cluster**, working first half-closed dc around the post of the next st looking 2 rows below, skip next dc, work 2nd half-closed dc around the post of the next dc 2 rows below. Yarn over to complete stitch. Ch 1, skip 3 shown behind the cluster just made, dc in next sc. Repeat * across.

5th row: Ch 1, sc in each st and ch-1 space across. Turn.

6th row: Ch 3, dc in each st across. Turn.

7th row: Ch 3, dc in each st across. Turn.

Repeat rows 2 - 7. Ending on Row 7 at the desired length you prefer. Leave enough yarn on the 2nd yarn ball to make the fringe for both ends.

Fringe

Cut strands into 8" strands. Place 3 strands together and fold in half to form a loop. Insert hook into edge stitch, pull loop through and wrap the hook with the 6 strands to secure.
