Caron Big Cakes

Hook
5.5 mm / Size I

Abbreviations

Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain
Dc = Double Crochet
Rep = Repeat
Sc = Single Crochet
Sl st = Slip Stitch
Sp = Space
St = Stitch

Special Stitches

X-st: Skip next st, dc into next st, cross back and dc into skipped st; 1 X-st made.

Pc (popcorn stitch): Work 4 dc into the next st, drop the loop from the hook, insert your hook from front to back under the top 2 loops of the first double crochet of the group; 1 pc made.

Project Size
42" x 42"

Instructions

Rnd 1: Ch 4, in 4th ch from hook, 3 dc, ch 1, (4 dc, ch 1) twice, 4 dc, sc to



top of beg ch. – 16 dc, 4 ch-1 sp

Small Repeat

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sp as join, sc in each st to ch-1 sp, *3 sc in ch-1 sp, sc in each st to ch-1; rep from * twice more, sc in same sp as beg 2 sc, sl st to beg sc. – 28 sc

*This is when I like to place a stitch marker in the middle stitch of each corner from here out to keep track of my place.

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc now and throughout), 2 dc in same sp as join, [*sk next st, dc in next st, dc in skipped st (X-st), rep from * to corner st, 5 dc in corner], rep on all 4 sides, ending with 2 dc in same sp as beg 3 dc, sl st to beg dc. – 12 X-st, 20 dc

Rnd 4: Rep round 2. – 52 sc

Rnd 5: Ch 2 (counts as hdc now and throughout), hdc in same sp as join, [*hdc, pc, hdc; rep to corner, 3 hdc in corner st], rep on all 4 sides, ending with 1 hdc in same sp as beg ch 2, sl st to beg ch 2. – 16 pc, 44 hdc

Large Repeat

Rnd 6: Rep round 2. – 68 sc

Rnd 7: Rep round 3. – 32 X-st, 20 dc

Rnd 8: Rep round 2. – 92 sc

Rnd 9: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp as join, dc in each st around, with 5 dc in each

corner to beg, 2 dc in same sp as beg ch 3, sl st to beg ch 3. – 108 dc

Rnd 10: Rep round 2. – 116 sc

Rnd 11: Rep round 3. – 56 X-st, 20 dc

Rnd 12: Rep round 2. – 140 sc

Rnd 13: Pc round. This is a rep of round 5 except you will have an extra hdc right before you get to each corner. – 44 pc, 104 hdc

Rnd 14 - 16: Small repeat.

Rnd 17: Rep round 9.

Rnd 18 - 20: Small repeat.

Rnd 21: Repeat Rnd 5 with this exception. Ch 2, hdc in same sp as join, hdc [*hdc, pc, hdc] extra hdc before corner, 3 hdc in corner. – 72 pc, 164 hdc

Rnd 22 - 28: Large repeat.

Rnd 29: Pc round. Rep round 5. – 104 pc, 220 hdc

Rnd 30 - 36: Large repeat.

Rnd 37: Pc round. Rep round 13. – 132 pc, 280 hdc

Rnd 38 - 44: Large repeat.

Rnd 45: Pc round. Rep round 21. – 160

pc, 340 hdc

Rnd 46 - 48: Small repeat.

Rnd 49 - Repeat Rnd 9.

Edging Round: Ch 1, reverse sc in each st around with 3 rsc in each corner. Finish off.

Pattern Notes:

Rounds 13 & 21 are pretty much identical to Round 5. The exception is that they have an extra HDC before each corner. This keeps the pattern in balance.
