



Old Records on The Shelf Coasters by Michael Sellick

Yarn List

Lily Sugar'n Cream
1 Ball each of Red, Overcast & Navy

Hook

5.5 mm / Size I

Abbreviations

Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain
Dc = Double Crochet
Rep = Repeat
Sc = Single Crochet
Sl st = Slip Stitch
Sp = Space
St = Stitch

Introduction

Inspired by one of my new friends, Michelle, from the Loosey Goosey Stitchers of Nova Scotia. Her goal was to make coasters for craft shows that are easy to make and a quick sell.

Project Size

5" Diameter

Instructions

Rnd 1: Using Red, ch 3, 11 dc in 3rd ch from hook. - 12 sts

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around. Fasten off red. - 24 sts

Rnd 3: Join Bright Navy to any sc. Ch 1, *sc next st, 2 sc in next st. Repeat * around. Join with sl st to beg sc. - 36 sts

Rnd 4: Ch 1, *sc next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st. Repeat * around. Join with sl st to beg sc. - 48 sts

Rnd 5: Ch 1, *sc next 3 sts, 2 sc in



next st. Repeat * around. Join with sl st to beg sc. - 60 sts

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in each st around. Fasten off and weave in ends - 60 sts

Vinyl Look

You now have 3 between row soaces of the black to play with. You will sl st with the yarn coming from back side of the coaster up through to the front side.

See video on Surface Overlay for clarification.

Goal is to get the first space to have just 3 sl st's. Spaced out equally across from each other. Surface crochet moving clockwise. You will have 2 equally spaced shiny lines appear.

Do second black layer space, starting at same spot of the first round, sl st 7 spaces. Do this 2 times.

Do third and final layer space, starting at same spot of the 2nd round. sl st 10 spaces. Do this 2 times.

Carefully fasten in the loose ends of the surface overlay to be nice and clean looking.

To finalize, wet block the coasters and let dry.

Now put the old records on the shelf and get dancing!
