5 - Caron® Cotton Cakes® Yarn – Beach Glass

1 - Ergonomic Aluminum Crochet Hook by Loops & Threads®

MEASURMENTS: Approx 58" [147.5 cm] wide x 40" [101.5 cm] deep at center back GAUGE: 13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc throughout.

Beg at center back, ch 6. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

1st row: (RS). Ch 3. (4 dc. Ch 3. 5 dc) in ring. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc (inc made). 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. 2 dc in last dc (inc made). Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. *Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. *Rep from * to * to next ch-3 sp. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to * to last dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn.

4th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each dc or ch-1 sp to next ch-3 sp. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. 1 dc in each dc or ch-1 sp to last dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn.

5th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 1. Skip next dc. Bobble in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. *Rep from * to * to last 3 dc before ch-3 sp. Ch 1. Skip next dc. Bobble in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. (1 dc. Bobble. 1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc. Bobble. 1 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to * to last 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows until Shawl measures approx 58" [147.5 cm] wide, ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximately

Bobble = 4 dc in indicated stitch or space. Drop loop from hook. Insert hook in first of 4 dc and pull dropped loop through. Ch 1 to close Bobble.

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double Crochet

Inc = Increase(ing)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right Side

Sc = Single Crochet

Sl st = Slip Stitch

Sp = Space

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn Over Hook
