

# Hugs & Kisses Car Seat Cover by Jeanne Steinhilber



Intermediate

## **Bernat Blanket Yarn**

MC - 2 Balls CC - 1 Ball

#### Hook

8.0 mm / Size L

#### **Abbreviations**

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain

Dc = Double Crochet

Rep = Repeat

Sc = Single Crochet

SI st = Slip Stitch

Sp = Space

St = Stitch

# **Special Stitches**

**X-st:** Skip next st, dc into next st, cross back and dc into skipped st; 1 X-st made.

**Bobbles**: dc5tog. In the next stitch, \*yarn over, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops, rep from \* 4 times, until you have 6 loops on hook, yo and pull through all to complete 5 dc together.

### **Project Size**

26" x 37"

This works up very quickly with the blanket yarn. It is thick and squishy with lots of texture that would also make a nice play mat.

## Instructions

**Row 1:** With MC, ch 52, dc in 4th ch from hook and each ch across. Turn.



- 50 dc

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across. Turn. - 50 sc

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc now and throughout), X-st across to last st, dc in last st. Turn. - 24 X-st, 2 dc

Row 4: Rep row 2. Turn.

Row 5: Ch 2 (counts as hdc now and throughout), \*hdc, bobble, hdc; rep from \* to last st, hdc in last st. Turn. - 16 bobbles, 34 hdc

Row 6: Rep row 2. Turn.

Row 7: Rep row 3. Turn.

Row 8: Rep row 2. Turn.

**Row 9:** Ch 3, dc in each st across. Turn – 50 dc

Continue pattern of sc, X-st, sc.

Row 10 thru 17: Rep rows 2 thru 9.

This is the pattern. Continue working until you have completed a total of 6 pattern repeats. Finish off MC and attach CC in any corner

**Edging:** Sc around entire blanket, working evenly on the sides and 3 sc in each corner. Finish off.

## Tie Straps - Make 2

Row 1: With CC, ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn. - 1 sc

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in st. Turn. - 2 sc

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st. Turn. - 2 sc Rep row 3 until strap is 27"

Last row: Ch 1, sc2tog. Finish off.

I lay the cover over the car seat and then slip the straps through the X-st nearest the handle, pull up and tie to the handle to create a canopy.

Remember, never leave this over your

baby for an extented time. This should only be used as a protection from cold, wind and rain in the short periods of time when carrying the car seat in and out of the car. When in the car, you can easily roll the cover back to see the baby.
