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Yarn List

1 Ball - Caron Latte Cakes, Blackberry

Hook

6.5 mm / K Hook

Abbreviations

Bpdc = Back Post Double Crochet
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain
Rep = Repeat
Fpdc = Front Post Double Crochet
Sc = Single Crochet
Sl st = Slip Stitch
St = Stitch
Tog = Together

Revision 1

Introduction

Created with Caron Latte Cakes. The eyelash fiber is mixed in to give the look of the finished product a more faded colour and ultra soft feel.

Size: 9" deep x 13" dia.

Instructions

The cowl is worked in a continuous infinity revolution. This is achieved through being strategic when proceeding to rnd 2. The infinity cowl is permanently with a twist.

Option: If you prefer to have a regular cowl without the twist, do not flip the row when proceeding after round 1 and there will be no infinity twist to it.

This cowl is in multiples of 2 if you would like to change the size.



Ch 100, join with a sl st to beg ch to form ring. Careful not to twist ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each ch around. Before proceeding. Organize the project as if it was a regular cowl without a twist. Now, flip the beg sc down so you will start crocheting on the bottom side of the sc. Do not join, you will work in a continuous round from this point. Place stitch marker.

Rnd 2: Dc in each st until you get back to the stitch marker. Due to the infinity, this causes the project to grow outward from the beg ch on both sides. Move stitch marker to last st.

Rnd 3: *Fpdc in next st, bpdcc in next st. Repeat * around to stitch marker. The ribs are now established.

Rnd 4 to End: *Fpdc in next st, bpdcc in next st. Repeat * until you are satisfied for the depth of your cowl.

Final 3 Sts: Once Satisfied and appears close to the original stitch markers you had, apply 3 sc in a row. Fasten off and weave in ends.

My cowl uses about 3/4" of a ball of Caron Latte Cakes. I could have went and made it much deeper.
