




Boxed Block Stitch Hexagon Blanket

Yarn List

4 Balls - Bernat Velvet, 1 each.
MC - Sunshine
A - Terracotta
B - Quiet Pink
C - Smokey Gray



Hook

6.5 mm / K Hook

Size

Unlimited Once In Boxed Block Stitch Section

Originally designed by Michael back in 2011. Yarn was discontinued and pattern wasn't worded corrected. Revised with different stitch counts. The originally used long striping yarn.



Abbreviations

- **Approx** = Approximate(ly)
- **Beg** = Begin(ning)
- **Ch** = Chain(s)
- **Dc** = Double crochet
- **Rep** = Repeat
- **RS** = Right Side
- **Rnd(s)** = Round(s)
- **Sc** = Single crochet
- **Sl st** = Slip stitch
- **Sp(s)** = Space(s)
- **St(s)** = Stitch(es)
- **V-st** - Dc, ch 1, dc in same st.
- **WS** = Wrong Side
- **Yoh** = Yarn over hook

Revision 1

Sizing

5 mm / H Hook - Small to Medium
5.5 mm / I Hook - Large
6 mm / J Hook - X-Large

Special Notes

- Attaching with slip stitch at the end of each round is done using single crochet to top of beginning ch-3.
- When starting a new round, slip stitch around the single crochet join, then begin ch 3 to start.
- Carry yarn up behind the project keeping it tot.
- In the boxed block stitch area, I used 2 colours in the first section. In the second section, I used 1 colour from the 1st section plus a new colour. In the 3rd section, I use the new colour in the second section plus a new colour and so on. This creates the transitional look of colours.

Instructions - Center Solid Hexagon

This section consists of 15 rounds. There are two rounds for each colour.

With MC, ch 4. Join with sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3, 2 dc in ring. Ch 1. *3 dc in ring. ch 1. Repeat from * 4 times. Join with sc to top of beg ch-3. - 3 sts per side

Rnd 2: Sl st around joining sc. Ch 3 (counts as dc). *1 dc in each of the next st to next ch-1 sp. * V-st in ch-1 space (corner). Dc in each st to next ch-1 sp. Repeat from * 5 times. Dc in final corner, join with sc to top of ch-3. Fasten off. - 5 sts per side

Rnd 3: With B. Fasten on with sl st around sc join. Repeat rnd 2. - 7 sts per side

Rnd 4: Repeat rnd 2. Fasten off. - 9 sts per side

Rnds 5 - 6: Using A. Repeat Rnds 3 - 4. - 11 sts & 13 sts per side

Rnds 7 - 8: Using C. Repeat Rnds 3 - 4. - 15 sts & 17 sts per side

Rnds 9 - 10: Using MC. Repeat Rnds 3 - 4. - 19 sts & 21 sts per side

Rnds 11 - 12: Using A. Repeat rnds 3 - 4. - 23 sts & 25 sts per side

Rnds 13 - 14: Using C. Repeat rnds 3 - 4. - 27 & 29 sts per side

Rnd 15: Using B. Repeat rnd 3. Fasten off. - 31 sts per side

Boxed Block Section 1

We are going to establish the repetitive steps for the boxed block stitch for the remaining of the blanket. Each boxed block section consists of 6 rnds.

Section 1 puts the boxed block stitches in balance. The difference between Rnd 1 of the first block section and the remaining block sections is the **red bold** instruction place in rnd 1 of the first section.

Rnd 1: Fasten on MC around sc in corner. Ch 3. **{Skip next st. Dc in next 2 sts. [Ch 2, skip 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts.] Repeat [] to corner.} *V-st in next corner. Repeat { } repeat for all sides. Dc in final st. Join with sc with final pull through of next colour to top of beg ch-3. Do not fasten off. Carry yarn behind afghan up for every alternative odd rnd. - 7 ch-2 spaces per side.**

Rnd 2: Using A, slip st around sc join. Ch 3. Dc in each st and place 2 dc in each ch-2 space to next corner. *V-st in corner. Dc in each st and place 2 dc in each ch-2 space to corner. Repeat * around. Dc in final corner. Join with sc with final pull through of MC to top of beg ch-3. Do not fasten off. Carry behind for every odd numbered row.

Rnd 3: Using MC, slip st around sc join. Ch 3. Dc in next 4 sts. [Ch 2, skip 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts.] Repeat [] to corner. 1 dc in final 2 sts} *V-st in next corner. Repeat { } repeat for all sides. Dc in final st. Join with sc with final pull through of next colour to top of beg ch-3. Do not fasten off. Carry yarn behind afghan up for every alternative odd rnd. - 7 ch-2 spaces per side.

Rnd 4: Repeat rnd 2.

Rnd 5: Using MC, slip st around sc join. Ch 3. Dc in next 6 sts. [Ch 2, skip 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts.] Repeat [] to corner. 1 dc in final 2 sts} *V-st in next corner. Repeat { } repeat for all sides. Dc in final st. Join with sc with final pull through of next colour to top of beg ch-3. Do not fasten off. Carry yarn behind afghan up for every alternative odd rnd. - 7 ch-2 spaces per side.

Rnd 6: Repeat rnd 2. Fasten off A.

Keep MC going but use it on even number rounds. Use B for the odd number of rows for section 2.

Section 2 & Beyond

Rnd 1: Fasten on B around sc in corner. Ch 3. {Dc in next 2 sts. [Ch 2, skip 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts.] Repeat [] to corner.} *V-st in next corner. Repeat { } repeat for all sides. Dc in final st. Join with sc with final pull through of next colour to top of beg ch-3. Do not fasten off. Carry yarn behind afghan up for every alternative odd rnd. - 7 ch-2 spaces per side.

Rnd 2 - 6: Using new colour scheme, and repeat rnds 2 - 6 as written in Boxed Block Section 1.

Repeat Section 2 until you are satisfied with the size of your blanket. You will be able to get a large size blanket from the yardage of the Bernat Velvet Yarn.
