



## Crochet Key Card Holder

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### Yarn

- Recommending Scrap Yarn using **100% cotton** such as Lily Sugar'n Cream or Bernat Handicrafter Yarn.

### Hook

- 4.5 mm / US 7

### Sizing

- 2.5" x 4" long

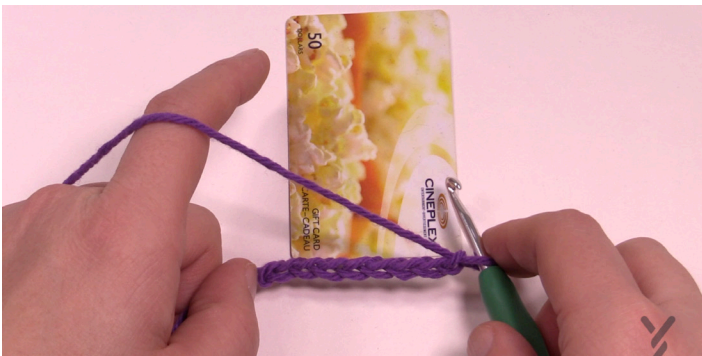
### Abbreviations

Beg = Begin(ning)  
Ch = Chain  
Rep = Repeat  
Sc = Single Crochet  
Sk = Skip(ped)  
Sl St = Slip Stitch  
St = Stitch(es)

### Instructions

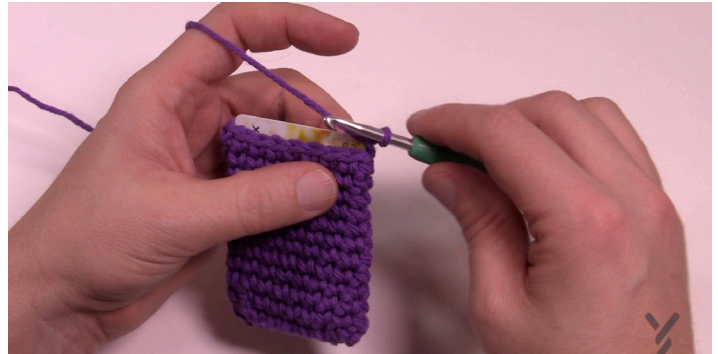
Key cards are the size of a credit, banking or gift card generally. If you don't have your key card at the time of making this, just substitute the card for sizing.

**Foundation Chain:** Lay down the card in front you. Ch the length of card.



**Rnd 1:** Sc 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to 2nd last ch. Begin to rotate as you put in 3 sc in last chain. 1 sc on the underside of the foundation to 2nd last st. 2 sc in last st. **Do not join.**

**Continuous Rounds:** Working in continuous rounds to the top of the card. 1 sc in each st. Use the card to see how tall the holder will be. Slide in the card to check. The card just peeks out of the top of the holder.



**Locate Hole:** With card inserted in holder. Sc across and identify the middle sc st. For the middle sc, ch 1, sk 1 st and sc in next to the other side of the holder. *This is now the back of the holder.*

**Continue Around to Front:** 1 sl st in each st to the other flat side of the holder. *This is the front of the holder.*

**Continue Around:** 1 sc in each st and ch-1 sp across to other side. Sl st in last st. Fasten off and weave in ends.
