



Easy Shells Wrap

Yarn

Patons Grace, 50 g/1.75 oz, 125 m/136 yds

- A - Viola - 2 Balls
- B - Navy - 2 Balls
- C - Cardinal - 2 Balls
- D - Lotus - 2 Balls
- E - Orchid - 2 Balls

Hook

- 4 mm / G Hook

Sizing

- 70" long x 13" wide

Abbreviations

- Approx = Approximately
- Beg - Begin(ning)
- Ch(s) - Chain(s)
- Dc - Double Crochet
- Hdc - Half Double Crochet
- Pat = Pattern
- Rep - Repeat
- Sc - Single Crochet
- Sp(s) - Space(s)
- St(s) - Stitch(es)
- Yoh - Yarn Over

Using Patons Grace with 100% mercerized cotton is a great alternative for those in warmer climates. Cotton keeps you warm but also helps keep you cool. The colours with the 4 rows is really what makes this wrap look great. Once you start seeing the repeating of the colours happening, you can put down this pattern and easily follow the sequence to the end.

Instructions

With A, ch 78.

1st row: (RS). (1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in 6th ch from hook.
*Skip next 4 ch. (1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in next ch. Rep from * to last 2 ch. Skip next ch. 1 dc in last ch. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3. *5 dc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to last st. 1 dc in top of beg ch. Join B. Turn.

3rd row: With B, ch 3. Skip next 2 dc. *(1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in next dc. Skip next 4 dc. Rep from * to last 3 sts. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in top of beg ch. Turn.

First 3 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until all 140 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Fasten off

With A, work 2 rows.

**With B, work 2 rows.

With C, work 2 rows.

With D, work 2 rows.

With E, work 4 rows.

With D, work 2 rows.

With C, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.

With A, work 4 rows.

** Rep from ** to ** 5 times more.

Final colouring at the end.

With B, work 2 rows.

With C, work 2 rows.

With D, work 2 rows.

With E, work 4 rows.

With D, work 2 rows.

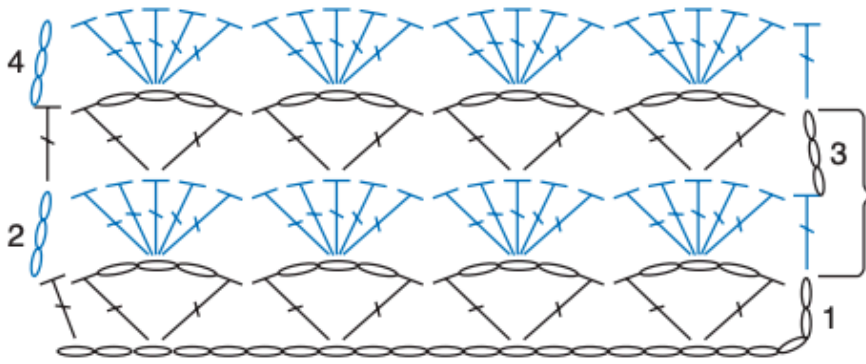
With C, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.

With A, work 2 rows.

These 140 rows complete Stripe Pat.
