

## Chevron Afghan Starting Chain Sizes Using Single Crochet

**Assumptions:** 5.5 mm / I Hook. Using Medium #4 Weight Yarn.

Multiples of 25 sts + 5 Extra Chains for Balance

Each Multiple creates 5.5" width, Inches Width Rounded up to Nearest multiple of 5.5".
