Assumptions: 5.0 mm / H Hook. Using Medium #4 Weight Yarn.			
Multiples of 22 sts + 3 Extra Chains for Balance			
Each Multiple creates 6.5" width, Inches Width Rounded up to Nearest multiple of 6.5".
