## Yarn

Red Heart Roll With It Melange - 150g / 5.29 oz, 356 m / 389 yds - Gossip - 1 Ball  
Bernat Super Value - 197g / 7oz, 389 m / 42 yds - White - 1 Ball

## Abbreviations

Beg - Beginning  
Ch - Chain  
Dc - Double crochet  
Rep - Repeat  
Rs - Right side  
Sc - Single crochet  
Sk - Skip  
Sl st - Slip stitch  
St(s) - Stitch, stitches

## Hook

- 8.0 mm / L Hook

## Sizing

- 11" x 54"

## Special Stitches

- **X-St** - Skip next stitch and place dc; dc into skipped stitch.
- **Bobble** - Dc3tog in the same stitch.

*This scarf is worked entirely by holding both yarns together. The larger hook with the double strands make this a quick, one-day project. See [The Crochet Crowd](http://TheCrochetCrowd.com) website for more of my Hugs & Kisses designs.*

## Instructions

Hold both strands together, ch 32.

**Row 1:** (RS) In 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc, sc in next 5 ch, sc3tog, sc in next 6 ch, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 6 ch, sc3tog, sc in next 5 ch, 2 sc in last ch. Turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in same st, dc in next 5 sts, dc3tog, dc in next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts, dc3tog, dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in last st. Turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 5 sts, sc3tog, sc in next 6 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, sc3tog, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last st. Turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, dc in next st, cross back to dc in base of ch 3 (X-st made), X-st 2 more times, dc3tog, X-st 3 times, 3 dc in next st, X-st 3 times, dc3tog, X-st 3 times, dc once more in last st. Turn.

**Row 5:** Rep row 3.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, bobble in next st, sc in next 2 sts, bobble, sc in next st, sc3tog, [sc, bobble, sc] twice, 3 sc in next st, [sc, bobble, sc] twice, sc3tog, [sc, bobble, sc] twice, sc once more in last st. Turn.

**Row 7:** Rep row 3.

**Row 8:** Rep row 4.

**Row 9:** Rep row 3.

**Row 10:** Rep row 2.

**Row 11:** Rep row 3.

Continue pattern repeating rows 4 - 11, 8 more times, until scarf measures 54" length. Fasten off.
