

The original mandala is themed after autumn colours. You can colour your mandala in any way possible. There are 7 colours used but you can add more or subtract colours from your own versions.

Colour Sequence

The designer, Lisa Gentry, has sequenced the colours in an order. For Mikey's version, he is going to honour the sequence of colours as it looks great; however, he is going to change the colours to be more Water Meets then Sand and Tropical Rain Forest.

Work 1 round with **A**, 1 round with **B**, 1 round with **C**, 1 round with **B**, 1 round with **A**, 1 round with **B**, 1 round with **B**, 1 round with **C**, 1 round with **C**, 1 round with **C**, 1 round with **C**, 1 round with **E**, 1 round with **F**, 1 round with **B**, 1 round with **D**, 1 round with **A**, 3 rounds with **G**, 1 round with **F**, 2 rounds with **C**, 1 round with **E**, 1 round with **A**, 1 round with **B**, 1 round with **D**; repeat from * once more, 1 round with **C**, 1 round with **E**, and 1 round with **F**.

If you change the colour sequence, it will change the yarn quantities suggested for the pattern.

Diva Dan's Mix for Mikey

Goal was to mix the colours to be relaxing in nature. This is Mikey's example below using Diva Dan's colours.



Gauge - Video will be provided before launch.

The throw is working in a circle; therefore, you need to do a gauge check to match. If you decide not to match gauge, you run the risk of the throw not sitting flat.


Using the first colour yarn, create the first 3 rounds. **Do not cut yarn between rounds or at the end.** Take measurement and then frog out to save yarn.

- Rnd 1: Follow instruction. Sl st to next ch 1 sp.
- Rnd 2: Ch 1, then continue instructions. SI st to next ch 2 sp.
- Rnd 3: Follow instructions and then stop.

Rounds 1 - 3 = about 4" [10cm] diameter. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Colour Your Own Scheme

Draw your own colour scheme.



If the circle is about noticeably smaller, frog out and retry again with a larger hook.

If the circle is over 4" by what you think is significant. Frog and retry with next hook size down.
