## Yarn

Bernat POP! - 140g / 50z, $256 \mathrm{~m} / 280 \mathrm{yds}$ Blue Streak - 9 Balls

## Abbreviations

Beg-Beginning
Ch - Chain
Dc - Double crochet
Rep - Repeat
Rnd - Round
Sc - Single crochet
Sk - Skip
Sl st - Slip stitch
Sp - Space
St(s) - Stitch, stitches

## Special Stitches

- X-St - Skip next stitch and place dc; dc into skipped stitch.
- Popcorn - Work 4 dc into the next st, drop the loop from the hook, insert your hook from front to back under the top 2 loops of the first double crochet of the group, grab the dropped loop and pull it through the stitch; 1 pc made.
This is a blend of my Hugs \& Kisses and Modern Granny patterns. See The Crochet Crowd website for more of my designs.


## Instructions

## Start with the Modern Granny section.

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring, or use magic circle.
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, ch 1 [3 dc in ring, ch 1] 3 times; join with sl st to top of beg ch. - Four 3 -dc groups, 4 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 2: SI st in next 2 dc, [(sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp (corner made), ch 3] 4 times; join with sl st in first sc. -4 corners, 4 ch- 3 sps.

Rnd 3: (SI st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in first corner ch-3 sp, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp, [(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp] 3 times; join with sl st to top of beg ch. - 4 corners, four 3 -dc groups.

Rnd 4: SI st in next 2 dc, *(sc, ch 3, sc) in next corner ch-1 sp, ch 3, sc in next sp between corner and next 3-dc group, ch 3, sc in next sp between next 3-dc group and corner, ch 3; rep from * 3
more times; join with sl st in first sc. - 4 corners, 12- ch-3 sps.
Rnd 5: (SI st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in first corner ch-3 sp, 3 dc in next 3 ch-3 sps, *(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp, 3 dc in next 3 ch-3 sps; rep from * 2 more times; join with sl st to top of beg ch. - 4 corners, 12 - 3 -dc groups.

## Transition into Hugs \& Kisses section.

Rnd 6: SI st in next 2 dc, (sl st, ch 1, 2 sc) in first corner sp, sc in each st to next ch-1 sp, *3 sc in ch-1 sp, sc in each st to ch-1 sp; rep from * 2 more times, sc in same sp as beg 2 sc, sl st to beg sc. -72 sc
*This is when I like to place a stitch marker in the middle stitch of each corner from here out to keep track of the center stitch.

Rnd 7: Ch 3, 2 dc in same st as join, dc in each st to marked corner, *5 dc in corner st, dc in each st to marked corner; rep from * twice more, 2 dc in same st as beg ch 3 , sl st to beg ch 3. - 88 dc

Rnd 8: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to marked corner, *3 sc in corner st, sc in each st to marked corner; rep from * twice more, sc in same st as beg st, sl st to beg st. - 96 sc

Rnd 9: Ch 3 (counts as dc now and throughout), 2 dc in same st as join, dc in next st, [*sk next st, dc in next st, dc in skipped st (Xst), rep from * to marked corner st], **5 dc in corner, dc in next st, X-st to next marked corner; rep from ** twice more, 2 dc in same st as beg 3 dc, sl st to beg dc. - 11 X-st per side/ 44 X-st, 24 dc

Rnd 10: Rep rnd 8. - 120 sc


Rnd 11: Ch 2 (counts as hdc now and throughout), hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts, *pc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts; rep from * to marked corner st, **[3 hdc in marked corner st, hdc in next 2 sts, *pc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts; rep from * to marked corner st]; rep from ** twice more, 1 hdc in same st as beg, sl st to ch 2. - 9 pc per side/ 36 pc total, 92 hdc

Rnd 12: Rep rnd 8. - 136 sc
Rnd 13: Rep rnd 9. - 16 X-st per side/ 64 X-st total, 24 dc
Rnd 14: Rep rnd 8. - 160 sc
Rnd 15: Ch 3, 2 dc in same st, dc in each st to marked corner, *5 dc in corner st, dc in each st to next marked corner; rep from * twice more, 2 dc in same st as beg ch 3 , sl st to beg ch 3. - 176 dc

Rnd 16: Rep rnd 8. - 184 sc

## Transition back to Modern Granny

Rnd 17: Ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in same st, ch 3, sk 3 sc, *sc in next st, ch 3, sk 2 sc; rep from * to marked corner, **(sc, ch 3, sc) in corner st, ch 3, sk 3 sc, (sc in next st, ch 3, sk 2 sc) to corner; rep from ** twice more, sl st to beg sc. - 4 corners, $60 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$

Rnd 18: (SI st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in first corner ch-3 sp, 3 dc in each ch-3 sp to corner, *(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc ) in corner ch-3 sp, 3 dc in each ch-3 sp to corner; rep from * twice more, sl st to beg ch. - 15(3dc groups) per side/ 60 (3-dc groups total), 4 corners

Rnd 19: SI st in next 2 dc, *(sc, ch 3, sc) in next corner ch-1 sp, ch 3, sc in next space between corner and next 3-dc group, ch 3, sc in next space between each 3-dc group to corner, ch 3; repeat from * 3 more times; join with sl st in first sc. - 4 corners, 68 ch- 3 sps

Rnd 20: Rep rnd 18. - 17 (3-dc groups) per side/ 68 (3-dc groups) total, 4 corners

Rnds 21-22: Rep rnds 19 and 20.
Rnd 23: Rep rnd 6. - 264 sc
Rnd 24: Rep rnd 7. - 280 dc
Rnd 25: Rep rnd 8. - 288 sc
Rnd 26: Rep rnd 9. - 35 X-st per side/ 140 X-st total, 24 dc
Rnd 27: Rep rnd 8. - 312 sc
Rnd 28: Rep rnd 11. - 25 pc per side/ 100 pc total, 220 hdc

Rnd 29: Rep rnd 8. - 336 sc
Rnd 30: Rep rnd 13. - 40 X-st per side/ 160 X-st total, 24 dc
Rnd 31: Rep rnd 8. - 352 sc
Rnd 32: Rep rnd 15. - 368 dc
Rnd 33: Rep rnd 8. - 376 sc
Rnds 34-50: Rep rnds 17-33.
Rnds 51-66: Rep rnds 17-32.

## Border

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 2 sc first st, sc in next st, [sk next st, sc in next st, sc in skipped st] to marked corner, *3 sc in corner st, sc in next st, [sk next st, sc in next st, sc in skipped st] to marked corner; rep from * 2 more times, sc in sam st as beg 2 sc , sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.
