



## Crochet Sanitizer Bottle Holder



Skill Level: Easy

| Size: Holds 2 oz Bot.

| Hook: 5 mm / H Hook

### Yarn

**Bernat Handicrafter**, 1.75 oz, 50g.  
Contrast A - Mod Blue - 1 Ball

You can substitute Lily Sugar'n Cream or Peaches and Cream for this. Use 100% cotton as it's machine washable and really strong.

Work in continuous rounds to avoid the slip stitching.

Designed for Purell Bottles that are 2 oz, 50 ml.

### Abbreviations

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

Sl St = Slip Stitch

Ch = Chain(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Rs = Right Side

Sc = Single Crochet

### Instructions

#### Ch 5

**1st rnd:** 1 sc 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next 2 ch. 3 sc in last chain. Turn upside down to use same chain. 1 sc in next 2 ch. 2 sc in last ch. Do not join. 10 sts.

**2nd rnd:** 1 sc in next 4 sts. 3 sc in next st. 1 sc in next 4 sts. 3 sc in next st. Do not join. 14 sts.

**3rd rnd to top of body of bottle:** 1 sc in st around. Do not join. Continue going around until top of body of bottle. Approx 3" pouch.

Lay pouch flat. Skip middle st, ch 1 and do one final round. Go past the ch 1 sp with putting sc in sp. 1 sc in next 2 sts. Sl st in next. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Using clip, slide through ch 1 sp hole.
