



Caron Cakes Wavy Afghan



Skill Level: Easy

| Size: Varies

| Hook: 4 mm / G

Yarn

Caron® Cotton Cakes™

Minimal Amount - Spare Yarn

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook.

Gauge

Doesn't apply.

Crochet directly over the wires.

Abbreviations

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Sc = Single crochet

St = Stitch

Standing Sc - Put slip knot on hook first, yarn over the cord and two loops will be on hook. Pull through 2 loops - *standing single crochet made.*

On the apply earphones, there are two elements that are added to the cord in which you have to jump over. For myself, I don't use my headphones for taking phone calls but I decided to jump over the volume and microphone control just in case I will use it in the future. Also, there is a clip where the head phones can be rolled up and clipped but I don't use that for this application. I just jumped over it as well.

I used spare yarn, in this case, Caron Cotton Cakes. Cotton is more durable for wear and tear.

Instructions

Start with standing sc around the corner just below the ear buds on the corner. Ensure to single crochet over the starting strand so it hides it under the stitches. Single crochet

evenly down the cord. If jumping over the volume/microphone, I chained 7 times and started to single crochet on the corner on the other side. Continue to crochet to where the second ear bud cord meets. Fasten off.

Start again on the other ear bud cord. This time, jumping over the clip. I didn't do any chain spaces for that jump. Continue to where the other cord meets up. Fasten off.

Start again at the bottom of the cord where it attaches to your device. Start with Standing sc and crochet over top of the starting strand to hide it. Single crochet evenly all the way to where the other two corners meet up.

Slip stitch to the both of the already crocheted cords that go to the earphones. Fasten off and using tapestry needle, weave in the end under the stitches.
