

Crochet Hooded Baby Blanket

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Yarn

Bernat® Baby Blanket[™] (300 g/10.5 oz, 201 meters/220 yards) Pretty Girl 3 balls

Size U.S. L/11 (8.0 mm) crochet hook

Measurements Approx 36" x 36" [91 x 91 cm]

Abbreviations

Beg = Begin(ning) Ch = Chain Dc = Double crochet Dcfp - Double crochet front post Hdc = Half double crochet Rep = Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s) Sc = Single crochet SI st = Slip stitch Sp = Space St(s) = Stitch(es)

Instructions

Blanket

1st rnd: (RS) Ch 4, into the 4th ch from hook, 2 dc, [ch 2, 3 dc] 3 times, ch 1, join with 1 hdc into top of beg ch 4.

2nd rnd: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), 1 hdc in same sp, *dcfp in each st to corner,** (2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in ch 2 sp; rep from * twice, then from * to ** once, 2 hdc in beg corner, ch 1, join with 1 hdc to beg ch 2.



11th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 1 dc in same sp, *dc in each st to corner,** (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch 2 sp; rep from * twice, then from * to ** once, 2 dc in beg corner, ch 1, join with 1 hdc to beg ch 3.

12th - 17th rnds: Rep 11th rnd.

Hood

The hood is formed by attaching the first stitch to the edge. It then grows out like a pie shape before it's attached to the sides with single crochet.

1st row: Join in any corner with a sl st, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3, 2 dc in same st as ch 3, 1 dc in each st across to last st, 3 dc in last st. Turn.

3rd - 9th rows: Rep 2nd row.

You will now have a pie shape. Use your hook to single crochet the seams that match the hood. The join should be on the underside of the hood so the seam is inside the hood.

Single crochet holding one side of the blanket and the hood together. Evenly space the sc to the brim. Rep on the other side of the hood. Fasten off.

3rd - 10th rnds: Rep 2nd rnd.
