## Introduction

This concept is about getting your blankets to be heavier but also using up yarns you may have. Caron Cakes have the potential to be uniquely different each time.

When using this yarn, you will use 2 balls at the same time. One ball, use from the inside of the ball going outward. The second ball, use from the outside of the ball going inward. Sometimes the yarn colours meet for a small time frame creating the bands of solid colours. Where that happens in the project is a mystery. That's the fun part.

## Instructions

Ch 100

**Row 1:** 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 98 sc.

**Row 2:** (RS). Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). 3 dc in next sc. \*Skip next 3 sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. Skip next 3 sc. 7 dc in next sc. Rep from \* to last 14 sc. Skip next 3 sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. Skip next 3 sc. 4 dc in last sc. Turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 4 sc. \*Skip next 3 sc. 7 dc in next sc. Skip next 3 sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. Rep from \* to last 11 sc. Skip next 3 sc. 7 dc in next sc. Skip next 3 sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 4 rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 47".

Fasten off.
