

SUGARBUSH SLOUCHY HAT AND SCARF SET | CROCHET



MATERIALS

Sugarbush® Rapture™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 211 yds/193 m)

Sizes	S	M	L	
Main Color (MC) Smoky Spirit (1005)	3	3	3	balls
Contrast A Passion Plum (1012)	2	2	2	balls

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Wooden button ¼" [3 cm] for Hat.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

MEASUREMENTS

Hat: To fit head circumference

S 21" [53.5 cm]

M 22" [56 cm]

L 23" [58.5 cm]

Scarf: Approx 8" x 80" [20.5 x 203 cm], excluding fringe

GAUGE

14 dc and 9 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes:

- Ch 2 at beg of row or rnd **does not** count as hdc.
- Ch 3 at beg of row or rnd counts as dc.
- When changing colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of last st, then draw new color through rem 2 loops and proceed.
- Carry color not in use along side edge of work.

HAT

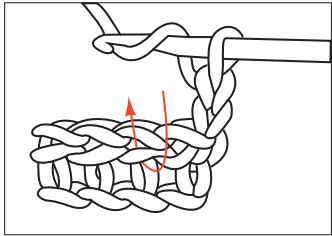
With MC, ch **66 (70-74)**. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring, taking care not to twist chain.

Ribbing: 1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in back hump of each ch around. Join with sl st to first sc. **66 (70-74)** sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each sc around. Join with sl st to top of first hdc.

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3rd to 6th rnds: Ch 2. Working in horizontal bar only, created by hdc at back of work, (see diagram), 1 hdc in each st around. Join with sl st to top of first hdc.



Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

7th rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in each st around. Join A with sl st to top of ch 3.

8th rnd: With A, ch 3. 1 dc in each st around. Join MC with sl st to top of ch 3.

Rep last 2 rnds 7 times more.

Next rnd: Ch 3. *Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * around.

33 (35-37) dc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Drawstring: With A, ch 100. Fasten off.

Weave drawstring through final rnd of dc. Pull drawstring tight for a slouchy hat or leave slightly open for a messy bun to pull through top. Sew wooden button to side of Hat on Ribbing band.

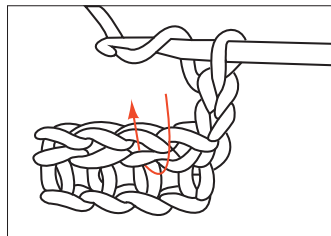
SCARF

With MC, ch 31.

Ribbing: 1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 30 sc.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

3rd to 8th rows: Ch 2. Working in horizontal bar only, created by hdc at back of work, (see diagram), 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn. Join A at end of last row.



Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

1st row: With A, ch 3. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Join MC. Turn.

2nd row: With MC, ch 3. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Join A. Turn. Rep last 2 rows 6 times more.

Next row: With A, ch 3. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Join MC. Turn.

Next 7 rows: Rep 2nd to 8th rows of Ribbing Pat.

Next 45 rows: Rep 1st and 2nd rows of Stripe Pat 22 times, then 1st row once.

Next 7 rows: Rep 2nd to 8th rows of Ribbing Pat.

Next 15 rows: Rep 1st and 2nd rows of Stripe Pat 7 times, then 1st row once.

Next 7 rows: Rep 2nd to 8th rows of Ribbing Pat.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each hdc to end of row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Pin Scarf to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Fringe: Cut strands of A 20" [51 cm] long. Taking 6 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe across both ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
