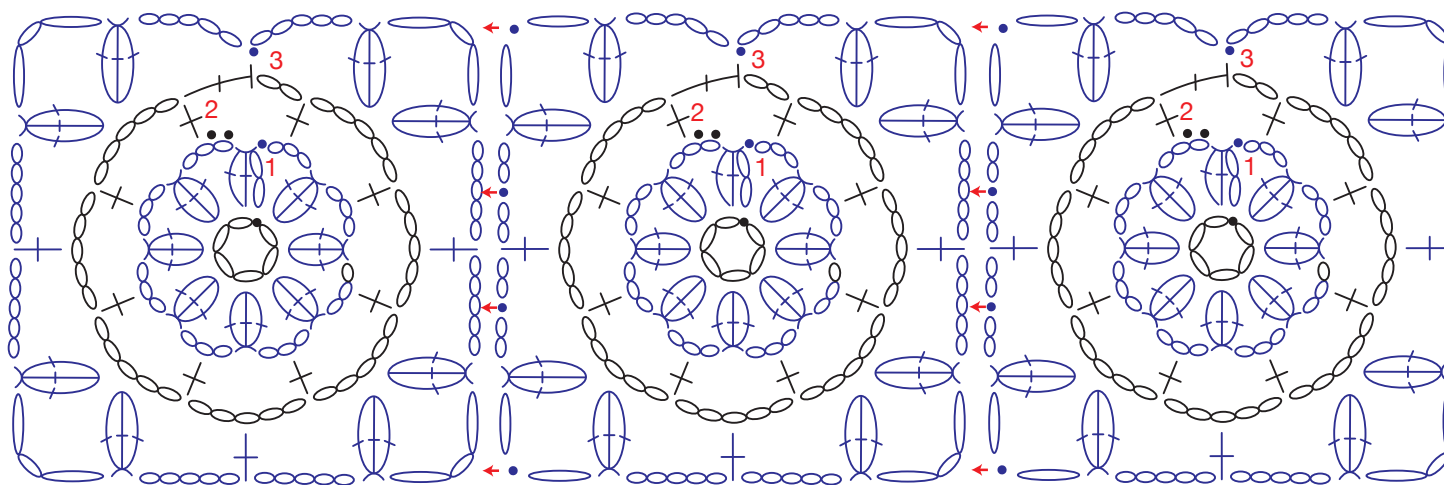


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- Slip Stitch

Motif 2

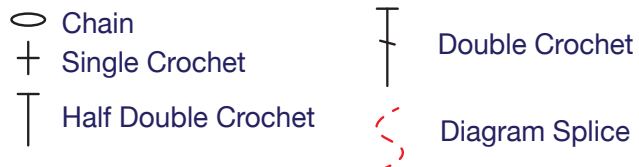
Motif 3 +  
Keep Joining until 15 squares are  
complete.

Make the first motif and  
the rest will join as you go.  
There are 15 motifs across  
each panel.

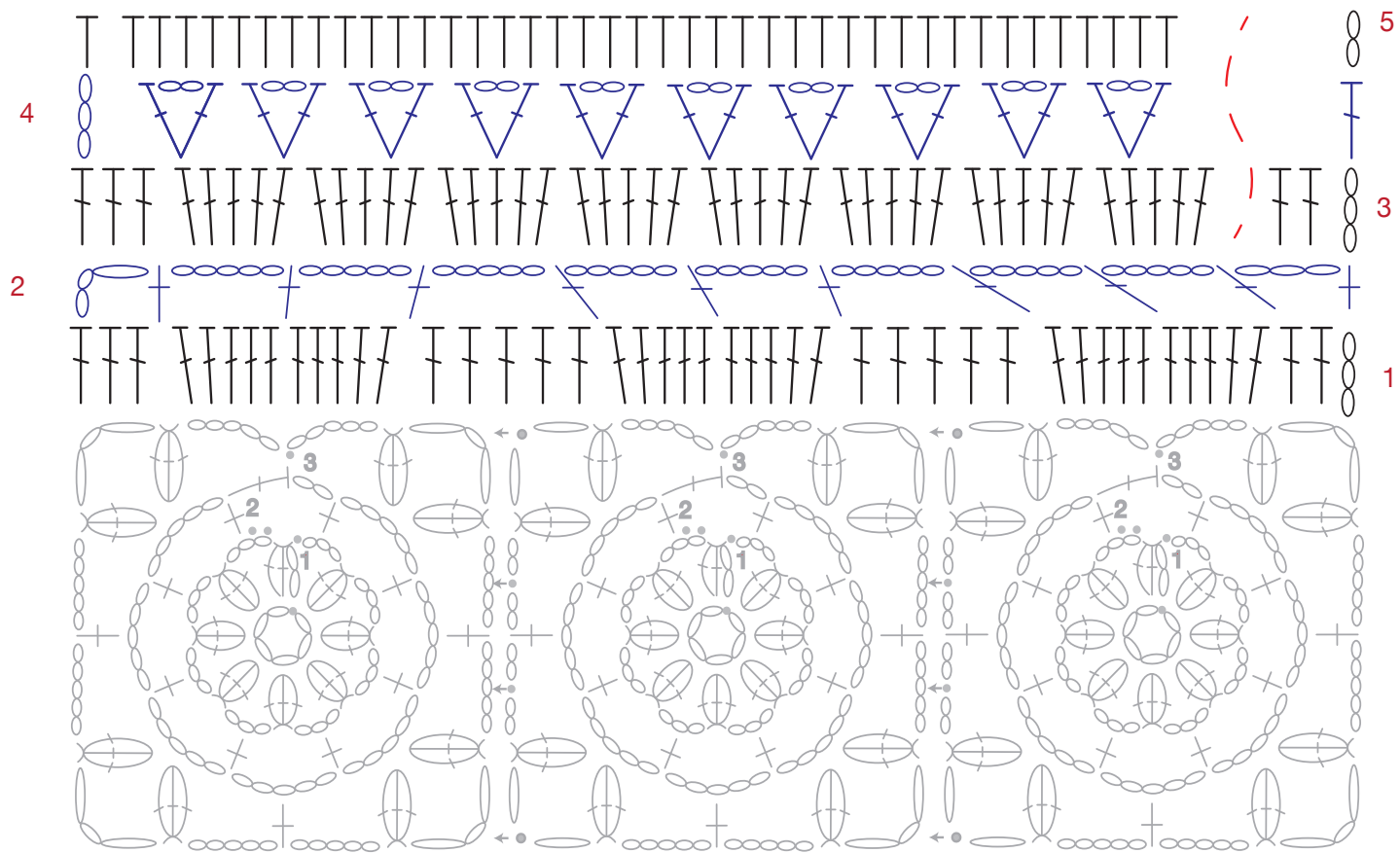
You need 15 motifs across  
for the math to work out for  
the edging or just improvise  
if you are customizing size.

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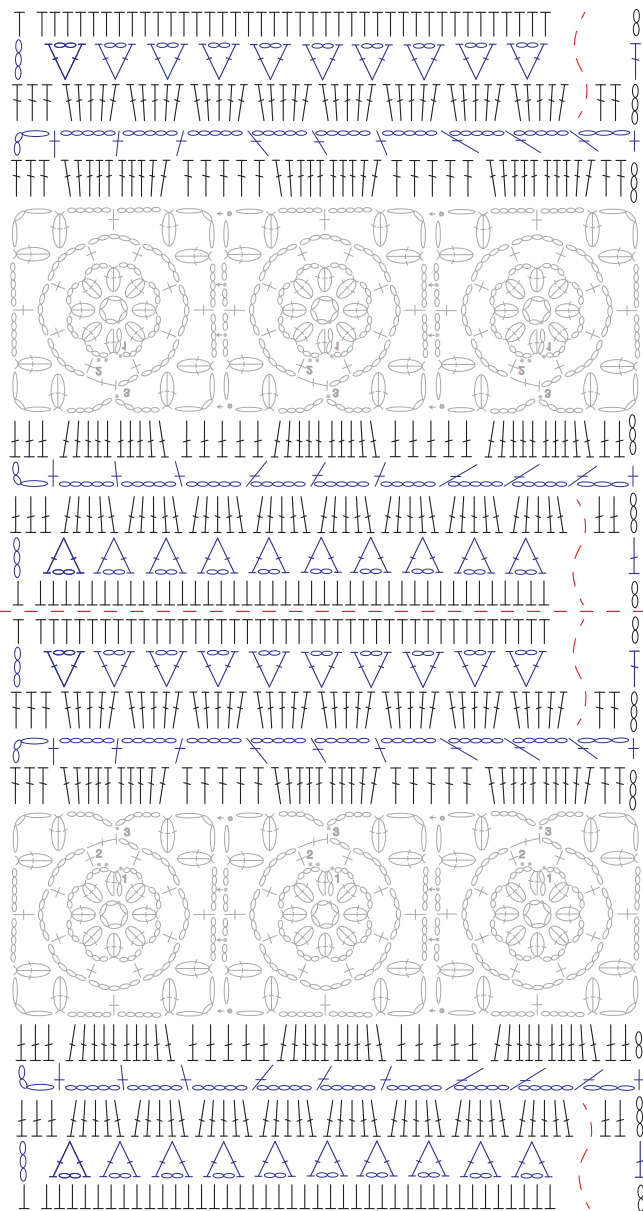
Add edging along the strips of joined motifs.



Repeat edging on this side of the motifs to form the complete panel.

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Once panels are completed, join them together with a whip stitch along back loops of the hdc rows.

Add fringe evenly across width of the blanket.
