



CUDDLES'N CLOUDS STRIPES | EASY

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Inspiration, Materials and Sizing

I have 4 assorted colours of Bernat Blanket O'Go on hand and I wondered about using all four in the same design and let the entire O'Go take its course.

The colours change when it wants to, so the striping isn't per row but random.

Bernat Blanket, 300g / 10.5 oz, 201 meters / 220 yards
A - Indigo Fads - 1 O'Go
B - Scuba - 1 O'Go
C - Mist - 1 O'Go
D - Agave - 1 O'Go

Hook 10 mm / N/15

Size: 38" x 50" [96 x 127 cm]

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Ch = Chain
Dc = Double crochet
Pat = Pattern
Rem = Remaining
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
Sc = Single crochet
St(s) = Stitch(es)

Notes:

The striping effect naturally comes out of the O'Go. So just use all of the yarn up and be conscious to finish up on the end of a single crochet row.

Ball order in materials is the same order that the sample was created with.

With A, ch 67.

1 st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 65 dc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc to

GAUGE: 8 sc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm]

Trfp = (Yoh) twice and draw up a loop around post of next dc 2 rows below at front of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times –trfp made.
Yoh = Yarn over hook

end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). *1 trfp around dc 2 rows below. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

4th row: As 2nd row.

5th row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). *1 dc in next st. 1 trfp around dc 2 rows below. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 dc in each of last 2 sts. Turn.

Rep 2nd to 5th rows using up all of the yarn. Be sure to finish on the end of a 2nd or 4th row.
