Jingle Balls Scarf

Firstly, I'm obsessed with this scarf. I'm totally going to wear this to Europe for Christmas! The scarf is 74" long x 5" wide [188 x 12.5 cm].

The colours shown are Fern, Stone, and Cardinal. Stone is the 3 single crochet strip in the middle. Stone is used for the fringing for both of the scarves.

Reserving Yarn

You will want to pull the yarn aside before you start your scarves with the chosen fringe colour. Each fringe is positioned every other stitch on the ends.

Jingle Balls has 18 fringes total (9 per end). Taffy Pull has 21 fringes total (11 per end)

Each fringe is made up of 3 - 12" stripes of yarn and secured to the ends of the scarf in fringe format. Put the yarn aside in a safe spot and crochet your scarves.

For Jingle Balls, stop when the scarf has run out of just one of the colours. It will either be Fern or Cardinal in this example. Attach the fringe when completed. Lay the scarf so the fringe dangles over an edge and carefully cut horizontally so all strands are even length. Mikey normally steams the fringe before cutting for best results.
